

TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

From Ronald Reagan National Airport

Super Shuttle Blue Van - 1-800-258-3826 or www.supershuttle.com

Reservations are recommended. Accessible vans are available upon request. Approximate one-way fare from Reagan National Airport: \$14.00 for the first passenger; \$10.00 for each additional passenger in the same party. There is also a \$1.00 booking fee.

Location: The Super Shuttle counter is located in Terminal A, B, and C baggage claim areas which are next to doors 4 and 9. If the counter is closed, dial the number given above.

To return to the airport, either call the 800 number listed above at least 24 hours in advance, use the Web address or ask the hotel's Concierge for assistance.

Metro

Metrorail (subway) provides service to/from Reagan National Airport only. Basic fares: \$1.60 non-rush hour; \$2.40 rush hour (6:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.) The blue line train marked either "Addison Road" or "Largo Town Center" stops at the Metro Center station, where the Grand Hyatt Hotel has an entry way.

Taxi

Approximate one-way fare: \$15.00-\$25.00 Approximate travel time: 20 minutes.

From Dulles International Airport

Reservations are recommended. Accessible vans are available upon request. Approximate one-way fare from Dulles Airport: \$29.00 for the first passenger; \$10.00 for each additional passenger in the same party. Location: The Super Shuttle counter is located on the lower level just before the East and West exits. A representative will escort you to the loading area. If the counter is closed, dial the number given above. To return to the airport, either call the 800 number listed above at least 24 hours in advance, use the Web address or ask the hotel's Concierge for assistance.

Metro

Metro provides bus service to/from Dulles International Airport only. One-way bus: \$10.00. This bus will go to "West Falls Church." At this stop, take Metrorail's orange-line train marked "New Carrollton" to the Metro Center station, where the Grand Hyatt Hotel has an entry way. Basic rail fares: \$1.60 non-rush hour; \$2.40 rush hour (6:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.)

Taxi

Approximate one-way fare: \$70.00 Approximate travel time: 45 minutes

From Baltimore Washington International Airport

Reservations are recommended. Accessible vans are available upon request. Approximate one-way fare from Baltimore Washington International Airport (BWI): \$37.00 for the first passenger; \$12.00 for each additional passenger in the same party.

Location: Go to the lower level baggage claim area to reach one of two Super Shuttle counters, located near Baggage Claim #1 and Baggage Claim #10. If the counter is closed, dial 888-826-2700.

To return to the airport, either call the 800 number listed above at least 24 hours in advance, use the Web address or ask the hotel's Concierge for assistance.

Taxi

Approximate one-way fare: \$75.00. Approximate travel time: one hour.

Shuttle to Train

Amtrak provides free shuttles to and from the BWI Marshall Rail Station. Shuttle stops are located on the lower level terminal roadway in between door numbers 1 & 2, 8 & 9, 14 & 15, and 17 & 18. Shuttle buses operate daily every 12 minutes from 5:00am to 1:00am and every 25 minutes from 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Buses stop adjacent to the rail station garage, directly in front of the rail station. The BWI Rail Station is one mile from the terminal building.

Amtrak trains run about once every hour from the BWI Marshall Rail Station to Union Station, Washington, D.C. One-way fares range from \$14.00 to \$42.00 per person. Tickets can be purchased at the BWI Rail Station or online at http://www.amtrak.com. Additionally, the MARC commuter rail Penn Line runs about once every hour from BWI to Union Station from about 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., weekdays only. One-way fare is \$6.00 per person. Tickets can be purchased at the BWI Rail Station or online at http://mta.maryland.gov/marc-train.

From Union Station, take Metro's red-line train marked "Shady Grove" to the Metro Center station, where the Grand Hyatt Hotel has an entry way.
