



## ALEC's model resolution - BBA

"in the absence of a national emergency the total of all Federal outlays for any fiscal year may not exceed the total of all estimated Federal revenues for that fiscal year, together with any related and appropriate fiscal constraints."





## **BALANCED BUDGET AMENDMENT**

why is it a bad idea?


A balanced budget amendment would be extremely damaging to states and to the country.

- Longer, deeper recessions costing jobs
- Puts Social Security and retiree assistance programs in jeopardy
- Threatens federal support for states
- Includes other damaging provisions




## Convention of States Project





## TALKING POINTS

- Runaway Convention
- Calls for a constitutional convention could put our most cherished freedoms, rights, and protections in jeopardy.
- A balanced budget amendment would cause more severe and frequent recessions, and hurt our most vulnerable.
- Special interests and lobbyists would likely play an influential role.
- Who are the delegates? How many votes would each state get?


## developing your strategy
